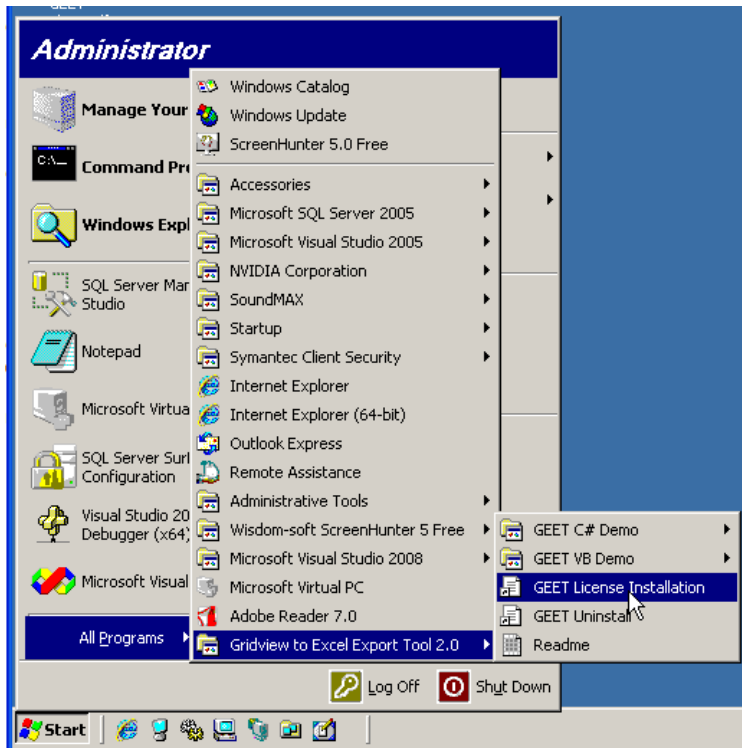
GEET 2.0 Free License Installation

This walkthrough will guide you through the steps to install a free License on either your client or your server machine.

It is convenient to remind that:

- 1) Licensing is free and timely unlimited on any desktop Windows (XP,Vista)
- 2) Licensing is free with a 6 months expiration limit on any Windows Server (2003/2008 Server)

To verify the license status of your installation press Start, Programs, Gridview to Excel Export Tool 2.0, then select GEET License Installation as next picture shows:



Next screen will show up:

Verify the “Currently Installed License” section: it should contain a code similar to the one you see in the previous picture.

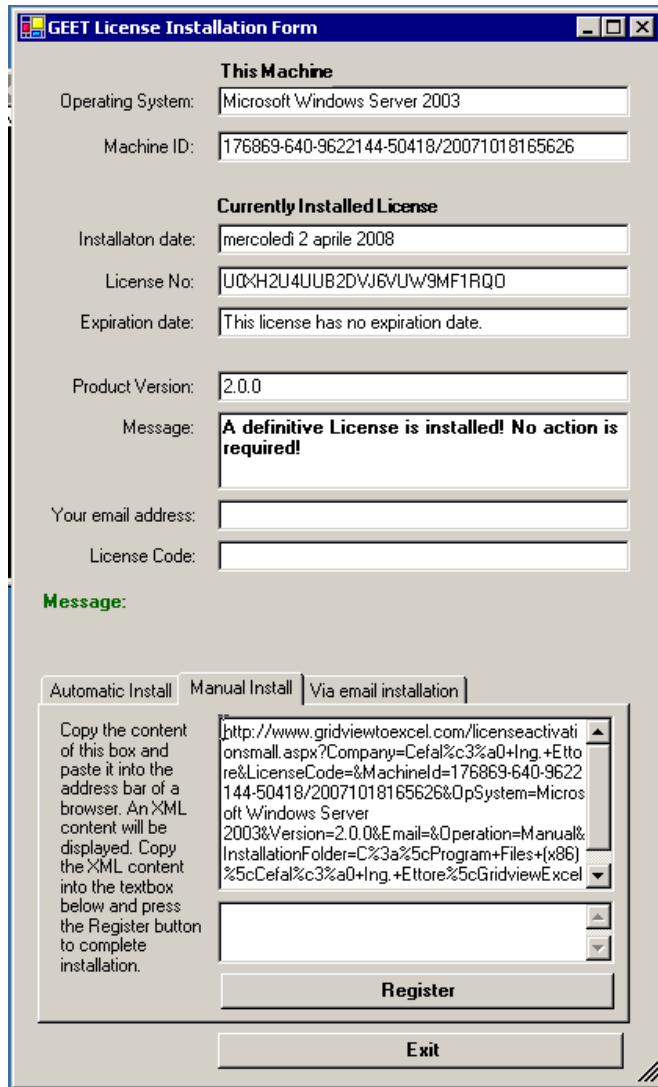
Please notice that License Codes are delivered by a Web Server and that each License Code works only with an Activation Key which is exclusively featured for the requesting machine.

If the License No. box is empty that means that your installation failed trying to connect to the internet.

Consequently you should try either the “Manual Install” or the “Via email install”.

Manual Install

Select the Manual Install tag; next screen will show up:



To install a free License:

- 1) Copy the URL of the lower box into the address bar of your browser (preferably I.E.)
- 2) Some XML code will be displayed into your browser
- 3) Copy that XML code into the lowest blank box of the Installation form
- 4) press the **Register** button.

A message box should display a message like “A temporary License is installed” and the Expiration Date box should show its “Expiration Date”.

Via Email Installation

Select the Via Email installation. You should see a window very similar to following one:

To install a free License:

- 1) Fill the "Your Email address" box
- 2) Copy the URL of the lower box into the address bar of your browser (preferably I.E.)
- 3) In a few seconds you should receive an email with an attachment containing your temporary license xml file.
- 4) Save the attachment in any folder reachable from your Server.
- 5) Press the "Register License File", navigate to the License File.
- 6) Open the file

The message box should display a message like “A temporary License is installed” and the Expiration Date box should show its “Expiration Date”.
